Governor Sonny Perdue recently signed an executive order establishing the McPherson Implementing Local Redevelopment Authority to develop an effective strategy for economic recovery.

The McPherson Planning Local Redevelopment Authority serves as the primary link between the DoD, the installation, the community, and Federal and State agencies for all base closure matters. The MPLRA is “the single entity responsible for identifying local redevelopment needs and preparing a redevelopment plan for the Military Department to consider in the disposal of installation property”.
