### **Lowe wins another AWARD!**

We are very proud to be part of a multi-million dollar dam project that will help create rafting rapids for the Chattahoochee River. The idea is to cut out a section of weirs down the center of the City Mills and Eagle Phenix-Dams to speed up the current. Lowe Engineers had to make a map of the bottom of a 3 mile section of the Chattahoochee River. The bathymetric and topographic survey included the river bottom and 300 ft. each side of the river to the waters edge. Currently, engineers are studying the data to see how the dam breaches will cause the river to change. Engineers are also looking at what needs to be done to keep boaters and kayakers safe, many of whom want to enjoy their sport and protect their playground.
